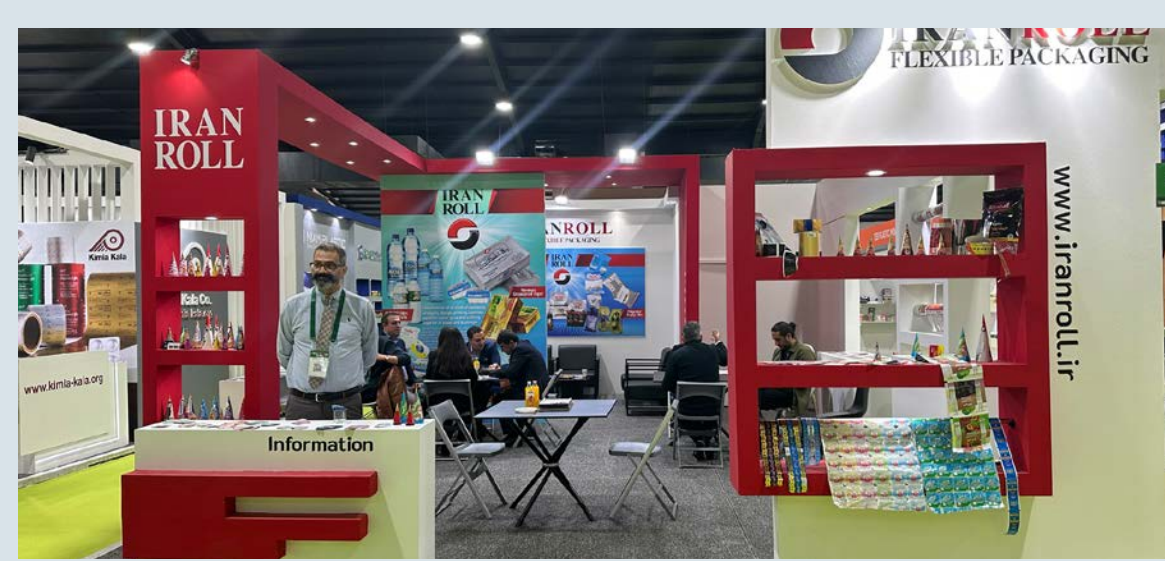

Impressive figures highlight Iraq's fast-rising plastics, printing, packaging and recycling industries.



• Booming plastic raw materials market

Iraq's imports of plastic raw materials skyrocketed at 21% annual growth from 40 kt in 2011 to 483 kt in 2024. (EUROMAP)



• Sharply rising plastic consumption and plastic consumption per capita

The country's plastic consumption per capita increased by 22% annually over the past years, from 0.5 kg in 2009 to 10.2 kg in 2024. (EUROMAP)



• Plastics technology on the rise

Between 2020 and 2024, Iraq's imports of plastics technology increased with an annual growth rate of 22.9%, from 25 million euros to 57 million euros. (VDMA)

• **Printing & paper technology** demand exploding
Imports in this sector grew by a massive 44% annually, from €13m in 2020 to €56m in 2024. (VDMA)



• High growth in packaging technology

Between 2020 and 2024, Iraq's imports of packaging technology increased with an annual growth rate of 9.7%, from 65 million euros to 94 million euros. (VDMA)

Initiatives to promote recycling have emerged in urban centres like Baghdad and Basra, focusing mainly on plastics and paper. Efforts are often community-driven, aiming to address waste management issues and promote environmental awareness among the population. Government support and international cooperation are crucial for scaling up these initiatives and establishing a sustainable recycling culture across the country.
